

Bandit's 2090 whole tree chipper: powerful *and* compact

Bandit's powerful 20" capacity drum-style whole tree chipper is now equipped with a massive 325hp Cummins diesel making this model a powerful and compact alternative for land clearing contractors specialising in whole tree take downs.

Being the most compact of Bandit's four whole tree drum-style chippers available, one of the key benefits of the Model 2090 is that this powerful machine measures under 2.5m in width and can therefore be transported without restriction.

The Model 2090 boasts a huge infeed throat of 24 ½" wide x 26" high. Its oversized 37" diameter x 26" wide drum head makes the 2090 extremely effective when chipping limby and crotch material.

The 2090's slide-box feed system has a top feed wheel 32" long x a giant 27" diameter that is powered by two hydraulic motors – one on each side of the top feed wheel. It is also equipped with a bottom feed wheel 32" wide x 10-5/8" diameter driven by one hydraulic motor. This feed system provides enormous torque and power for pulling and compressing large diameter forked and limby material.

As with all of Bandit's whole tree chippers, you can select from a wide range of options to best your land clearing requirements. The 2090 can be supplied with a self feeding loader arm and is also available with a CAT undercarriage as a self-propelled machine. Radio remote control is also a useful option that most owners choose.
