

STUMP GRINDERS FROM BANDIT **SHOWCASE HIGH PRODUCTION** WITH LOW MAINTENANCE

BANDIT STUMP GRINDERS HAVE BEEN CONTINUALLY HONED AND FINE-TUNED THROUGH THE YEARS TO DELIVER THE HIGH LEVELS OF PERFORMANCE AND LONGEVITY DEMANDED BY CUSTOMERS.



Bandit stumpers are primarily hand-built with the best materials available, utilising heavy-duty welded construction to help ensure these machines live up to Bandit's long-standing reputation for durability. At the stump, engine horsepower and heavy-duty hydraulic systems power Bandit stump grinders through the toughest projects. Wide swing arcs and precision controls minimise the on-site grinding time, and optional items like grading blades make stump grinding and clean up a near effortless operation.

And now, Bandit has taken stump grinding to a whole new level with the Model 2250XP and Model 2550XP beltless stump grinders. These revolutionary machines use a hydrostatic motor to directly power the cutter wheel, eliminating all the belts, shafts and the many pulleys and bearings that typically require regular adjustment and replacement. With a Bandit hydrostatic stump grinder it's not uncommon to see maintenance costs drop by 30 per cent or more compared to traditional stump grinders, without sacrificing the performance that stump grinding professionals need.

The Model 2250XP uses a heavy-duty 40cc hydrostatic motor to directly power its 20 inch (51cm) diameter cutter wheel.



Oversize bearings in the pump handle the shock loads from stump grinding, while an economical 27-horsepower engine powers the hydraulic systems and self-propelled undercarriage. The cutter wheel has a class leading 50 inch (127cm) swing arc that can also grind to a depth of over 12 inch (30cm), and at just 700kg it's one of the lightest four-wheeled, self-propelled stump grinders available.

Redlands Tree Service in Queensland recently purchased a Bandit 2250XP – "The lower centre of gravity on the 2250XP makes the machine extremely stable," said Andrew Stovell, owner at Redlands Trees. "The hydro drive makes it grind like a larger HP machine, so it is surprisingly fast."

The newest stump grinder from Bandit is the larger Model 2550XP. It takes the

beltless hydrostatic design of the 2250XP to the next level by offering four-wheel drive, wireless remote control, a hydraulic back fill blade and a powerful 44hp Kubota diesel engine all as standard equipment. It features a 21 inch (53cm) diameter cutter wheel with a wide 50 inch (127cm) swing arc, and it can grind to a depth over 12 inch (30cm). The Model 2550XP is the perfect stump grinder for tree care and landscape professionals looking for a low-cost, low maintenance, high performance machine.

Not to be outdone by the new kids on the block is the Bandit Model 2900XP track stump grinder. This machine has been on the market for more than five years with many units sold around Australia. It features a rubber-track undercarriage that can extend out to 53 inch (135cm) for added stability, then retract to 35 inch (89cm) for traversing narrow gaps and backyard gates – all at the simple flip of a switch. The 2900XP's cutter wheel swings in a large 74 inch (188cm) cutting arc and it can grind to a depth of 26 inch (66cm). With engine options up to 114 horsepower, even the largest stumps are done in a matter of minutes.

The days of complicated, heavy, clunky stump grinders that are expensive to operate and brutal on operators are in the past. Modern tree care companies and stump grinding specialists are turning to Bandit for stump grinders big and small, and with several models to choose from, there's a Bandit stump grinder to handle any job. Bandit's line of stumpers include small handlebar machines with unmatched mobility, mid-size self-propelled grinders with flotation tires and petrol or diesel engines with aggressive horsepower, and large track-drive stump grinders with remote control and hydrostatic drives. Whether it's an HB20XP "SideWinder", a brand new Model 2250XP or 2550XP hydrostatic direct-drive stumper, or a Model 2900XP with an expanding undercarriage, choosing Bandit is your first step to opening new markets – and realising greater profits – in the world of stump grinding.
